This year pupils will be expected to complete the following homework;

Maths (as well as practicing times tables weekly)

English (as well as learning spellings and daily reading)

Science (as well as key words)

French

Design Technology (Food project)

These will be set by their teacher and collected in on an agreed date which will be recorded in their diary.

In addition to these the following projects have been designed to encourage pupils to have free choice, independence and show their creativity. Three projects (or more if they wish) should be chosen from the following list and handed in to teachers week commencing Monday 5th December. We hope this will encourage pupils to manage their time effectively, ensure they are organised and build on the learning they receive in the classroom.

Creative Projects

Make a model of a new Toy Story toy. Design it on paper and include information about how you will make it and what materials you will use.	Create a 'Fact File' about travelling to space. Make sure you include lots of interesting facts to see if you can teach your teacher something new!	Sketch your favourite Toy Story character in pencil and use different techniques to add shade, tone and texture. You could repeat it using a different media
Design you own New York Deli style baguette. Write the recipe, make it and bring your teacher a picture of the finished project (before you eat it all).	Write your own toy themed story, make sure you use lots of adjectives to describe characters and setting. Try to include a morale in your story for younger children to learn from.	Create a holiday leaflet to persuade someone to travel to New York. Include; images of destination, attractions, Places to Eat, Hotels, Flight details and lots of persuasive language.
Build a model of our solar system. You could include a booklet that tells you about each planet.	Create a project on the 'Statue of Liberty'. Make sure you include lots of information about its history and why it is so important.	Build your own New York sky-line making sure you include some of the important buildings you would find there.
