

# Year 6



This year pupils will be expected to complete the following homework;

Maths (as well as practicing times tables weekly)

English (as well as learning spellings and daily reading)

Science (as well as key words)

Design Technology (Food project)

These will be set by their teacher and collected in on an agreed date which will be recorded in their diary.

In addition to these the following projects have been designed to encourage pupils to have free choice, independence and show their creativity. Three projects (or more if they wish) should be chosen from the following list and handed in to teachers week commencing Monday 5th December. We hope this will encourage pupils to manage their time effectively, ensure they are organised and build on the learning they receive in the classroom.

# Creative Projects

Write a story about the Titanic, a diary entry from a passenger on board or a poem that describes the ship itself or the disaster.	Re-create a dish that would have been served on-board. You could focus on the A la Carte restaurant or food that was served to lower classes.	Create a project booklet based on the Titanic including sections on the ship, crew, the journey, the disaster and White Star Line Company.
Build a model of the RMS Titanic or make an item that would have been found aboard.	Record the life of a cocoa bean as a comic strip. Make sure you story explains how beans become bars.	Design an outfit, hat or a piece jewellery that a 1st class passenger may have worn, you could even make it.
A chocolate recipe. Research a chocolate based recipe and rewrite it in your own words. Follow the recipe and don't forget to snap the finished product!	Research floating and create a poster demonstrating how ships float. Make sure to explain all the key vocabulary and include force arrows.	Answer the unanswerable question... Which chocolate is the best? Carry out surveys and taste tests on your friends and family present your findings on a PowerPoint.
