Titanic Trip

On Tuesday 4th October and Friday 7th October Year 6 will be heading north up the M6 to Liverpool to spend the day at the Voyage of Discovery at the Merseyside Maritime Museum.

The museum holds a major exhibition about the Titanic and pupils will be taking part in a series of activities and a workshop during the day. You can see more on their website <http://www.liverpoolmuseums.org.uk/maritime/> This is a wonderful opportunity to bring our learning to life and enhance the experience that we are building in school. I know pupils that have been in previous years have thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to take part in the workshop and to see some artefacts from the ship itself!

The year group will be split between the days as follows:

Tuesday 4th October: 6BS and 6CT

Friday 7th October: 6RB, 6MH and 6BR

The cost of the trip will be just £12. The preferred payment method is online via 'ParentPay' which can be accessed via our school website. Alternatively, you can pay by cheque made payable to 'Woodfield Academy' or cash returned in a sealed envelope clearly labelled with your Childs name, their class and the trip name, then placed in the black money box by the school offices. **Please can all money be paid in by 23rd September.**

The coaches will leave school at 7.00am and so we ask that all pupils arrive at 6.50am, meeting in the main school hall. We estimate we will arrive back to school at 6.30pm – updates will be posted on Facebook and my school app (<http://www.myschoolapp.co.uk>).

Due to the length of the day, we ask that pupils are provided with 2 packed lunches as well as snacks and drinks (pupils eligible for free school meals will receive 1 packed lunch and drink). Pupils will be expected to be in full school uniform for the day, and are able to bring a camera, but mobile phones and other handheld devices are not permitted. I know this will be a memorable experience and extremely educational, and in advance I would like to thank all the staff for giving up their time, enabling this trip to happen.

As with any visits of this type, we have the right to refuse attendance on the grounds of health and safety as well as behaviour.
