Please pay this amount as soon as possible.

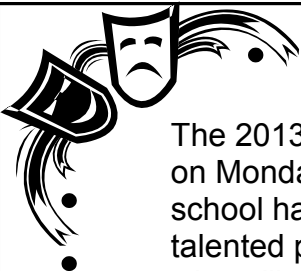
