Please note that a letter is going out to all parents and carers regarding school uniform, and full details of changes are in the magazine.

One of the main reasons for change is the many problems with the old red jumper—cost, availability and quality; many of you had expressed concern about these jumpers over the years.

The new optional black jumper must be a v-neck school type jumper (not a sweatshirt), all black, no logos. These are inexpensive and very easy to find.

The new ties are being phased in gradually, (see letter/magazine).

The black blazer with sew-on badge will become compulsory from September. All pupils will also be expected to wear this on their way in and out of school.
