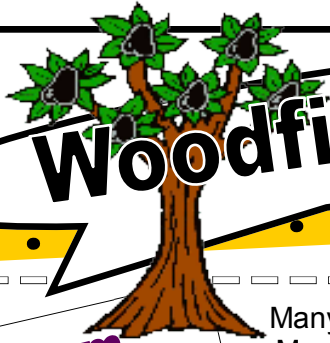

## A note from the Headteacher...

The tokens can be redeemed at most UK bookshops. Please help your child to use it on or around World Book Day by visiting your local bookshops or major supermarkets.

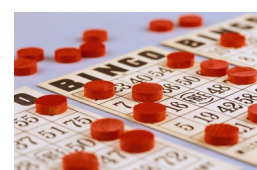
