A Titanic Trip!

On Wednesday 8 October and Friday 10 October Year 6 will be heading north up the M6 to Liverpool to spend the day at the Voyage of Discovery at the Merseyside Maritime Museum.

The museum holds a major exhibition about the Titanic and pupils will be taking part in a series of events and workshops during the day. The year group will be split between the days as follows:
