Dear Parents/Carers

We will be holding a meeting for Year 6 parents interested in learning more about the end of Key Stage Assessments (SATs) and how they can support their children to help them through these. This assessment is statutory and will take place in May this year.

The meeting will be on Wednesday 30th January at 6pm in the main hall.

The aim of the meeting is to discuss, in detail, the run up to and the week itself, talk over the Maths and English papers, share ideas to support with revision at home and discuss access arrangements pupils may be eligible for. Some parents have experienced SAT tests in KS2 with older siblings, however many changes have taken place in the organisation of the papers and pupils' reported scores over the past few years.

Miss Doidge, Mrs Georgi, Mr Preston, Ms Ellis and I will be talking to you throughout the evening and other members of the Year 6 team will also be on hand to answer any questions you may have.

In-school intervention is already taking place to support pupils with their key skills in Maths and English as well as extra sessions being offered to pupils after half term.

Could I also take this opportunity to ask you to check that your child's homework is being completed, as this is often an extension of classroom learning and contains areas that pupils need to focus on.

We would also like to ask that pupils attend regularly and refrain from taking time out of the school day to attend appointments in the lead up to SATs week commencing Monday 13th May 2019.

Please advise your attendance by completing the form on ParentMail before Monday 28th January 2019.
